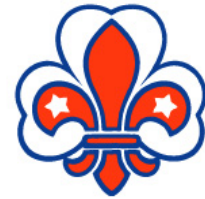

MADRID 2021 **29th WORLD CONFERENCE** **ADULTS SCOUTS & GUIDES** **ISGF – AISG**

The postponed ISGF World Conference will take place from **Tuesday 17 August to Sunday 22 August 2021** in **Madrid, Spain**. The exact venue is hotel Meliá Avenida América very close to Madrid Barajas airport and with excellent connection to the city center by metro, bus, and taxi. The organisers have proposed, as the general theme of the Conference: “growth, fun, friendship, service, adventure and diversity”.
